Am E Am

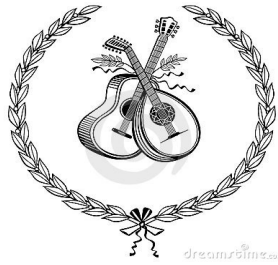
This town is just a graveyard to a love that is deceased
